Huntsman is a layered representation of two classic cheeses produced in the English countryside. Double Gloucester and Stilton. Double Gloucester is a firm, mellow and tangy cheese made only from the milk of Gloucester cows and Stilton Blue cheese is a blue-veined, strong, smooth and creamy cheese with a distinctive flavor profile.
